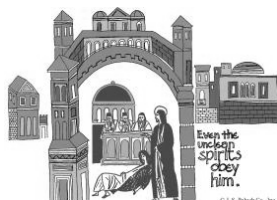

We are a vibrant Church called as disciples to serve the Lord and one another. "Called to be Merciful," we encounter God's love when we show mercy and compassion through stewardship, service, and sacrifice.

We invite you to share your resources with our diocesan ministries through a contribution to the ACA. Your gifts make possible the work that affects so many in our diocese by providing seminary formation for candidates to the priesthood, assisting many poor and vulnerable through Catholic Charities, and supporting Catholic schools and religious education programs.

Our own parishioners have opportunities to participate in Marriage Preparation and Enrichment programs offered in the diocese through the Office for Marriage and Family Life. Our youth have the opportunity to become better disciples in Christ through leadership programs, and our youth ministers receive support and training through the Office for Youth Ministry. Our catechists have opportunities to participate in diocesan in-service programs offered through the Office for Evangelization and Catechetical Ministry.

Our ACA assessment for 2015 is \$82,000. With your help, we are confident we can reach that goal. Once we reach our goal, the funds over and above our target amount are returned to the parish. Likewise, any shortfall must be paid out of our operating budget.

Registered parishioners will receive by mail a cover letter, the ACA brochure, and pledge card with return envelope. Non-registered parishioners are also encouraged to pledge. ACA brochures and pledge cards will be available in the pews next weekend. During the Masses on the weekend of February 7-8, you will be asked to put your completed pledge card into the collection basket. This will include a short video, a reflection on the diocesan vision for the network and discussion of the qualifications and responsibilities expected of parish mental health ministry team members.

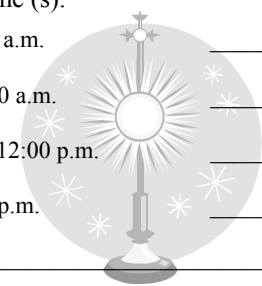
