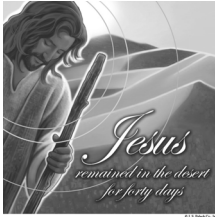

### Knights of Columbus Lenten Friday Fish Dinners



The Mission Parish's *Knights of Columbus* Council is hosting a series of Friday Fish dinners during Lent. Dinner will begin at **6:30pm**, in the California Room, please pay at the door.

Please join us for our **Fish Dinners** on **Fridays through March 27th**. You are welcome to attend 5:30pm Mass, followed by Stations of the Cross and then walk to the California Room for dinner. Cost will be \$15 for adults, \$10 youth (12-20yrs) and \$5 for children (5-11yrs).

### Lenten Season

**Fridays of Lent-5:30 pm Mass followed by Stations of the Cross and Fish Dinner in the California Room.**

**ABSTINENCE**—is a penitential practice consisting of refraining from the consumption of meat and is to be observed by all Catholics who are 14 years of age and older. Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and the Fridays during Lent are days of abstinence.

**FASTING**—In addition to abstinence, fasting is to be observed by all Catholics between the ages of 18-59 years (inclusive) on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On days of fasting, one full meal is allowed. Two smaller meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken according to one's needs, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, they are urged to practice other forms of self-denial that are suitable to their condition.

It means that you can have some time alone with Jesus to pray your favorite prayers, read the Bible, contemplate acts of faith, hope, charity, thanksgiving, reparation, pray a rosary or do whatever type of prayerful devotion that suits you before Our Lord. You can just sit and say nothing simply keeping Him company, just as you would with a dear friend.

I volunteer to spend one hour before the Blessed Sacrament on First Friday, **March 6** in La Capilla (the Chapel behind the Mission Church).


