You are invited to join Sister Mary Kiely, ofsf, Director of the Mission's Youth Ministry, in the California Room to view a lecture series on St. Francis and his life. The sessions are weekly on the following **Tuesdays: July 21 and 28 from 10:00-11:30 am.** This series will be presented in 30 minute videos, 2 per session and will be facilitated by Sister Mary. Some

of the topics are "Why Francis of Assisi is Alive Today," "From Worldly Knight to Knight of Christ," and "The Local World Francis Inherited," to mention only three. There is no fee for this event.

**The Franciscan School of Theology (FST)** offers two primary graduate degrees: Master of Theological Studies and Master of Divinity. **What do you actually do during adoration?** You may sign up to be an "adorer" which allows you to schedule yourself for one or more hours to pray before the very presence of Our Lord, exposed in the monstrance. It means that you can have some time alone with Jesus to pray your favorite prayers, read the Bible, contemplate acts of faith, hope, charity, thanksgiving, reparation, pray a rosary or do whatever type of prayerful devotion that suits you before Our Lord. You can just sit and say nothing simply keeping Him company, just as you would with a dear friend.

I volunteer to spend one hour before the Blessed Sacrament on First Friday, **Aug. 7** in La Capilla (the Chapel behind the Mission Church).
