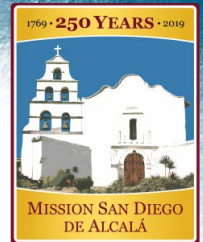


## Devotion to Honor Saint Junípero Serra

In 1768, Father Serra assumed leadership of the missions of Lower California and in 1769, Upper California (modern day California). On August 28, 1784, worn out by his apostolic labors, Father Serra was called to his eternal rest. He was beatified by Pope John Paul II on September 25, 1988. He was canonized by Pope Francis on September 23, 2015 in Washington, DC. His feast day is July 1.
